- A research project proposal is a concise document that dictates or showcases the issues, concerns, and/or current conditions that you would like to address and have a solution for with the help of the research project that you would like to execute
- A research project proposal helps present and outline the current state in which the knowledge underlies
- A research project proposal demonstrates your interests as a researcher

- If we have created a research project proposal for academic purposes, then our academic institution can use our proposal to align and match our research project to a fit research project adviser or supervisor whose expertise and professional background are related to the study that what we presented
- A research project proposal can gauge your potential as a researcher. This document demonstrates your deliverable and aptitude to immerse in research processes

# A basic research project proposal usually contains the following information

- The title of the research project being proposed
- The specification that the document is a proposal for a research project
- The abstract of the research project
- The background or context that supports the intention of the research project
- The research project questions that you would like to answer
- The initial research methods that you will use
- The specification of the originality and significance of the research project being proposed
- A bibliography
