## Concept Note, Abbreviation Explanation and Coding:

#### **Concept Note:**

- 1. CBCS is a mode of learning in higher education which facilitates a student to have some freedom in selecting his/her own choices, across various disciplines for completing a UG/PG program.
- 2. A credit is a unit of study of a fixed duration. For the purpose of computation of workload as per UGC norms the following is mechanism be adopted in the university:
  - One credit (01) = One Theory Lecture (L) period of one (1) hour;
  - One credit (01) = One Tutorial (T) period of one (1) hour;
  - One credit (01) = One practical (P) period of two (2) hours.
- 3. Course: paper/subject associated with AECC, DSC, DSEC, SEC, VBC, OEC, VC, IC and MIL
- 4. A candidate shall not opt for more than one language under core subjects
- 5. In case of BA, once a candidate chose two courses/subjects of a particular two department in the beginning and then approved, he/she shall continue the same till the end of the degree, then there is no provision to change the course(s) and department(s).
- 6. A candidate shall chose one of the department's course as major and other department course as minor in fifth and sixth semester and major course get continued in higher semester.
- 7. In case of OEC, a candidate is not allowed to choose course/subject of home departments (Two DSCs).





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- 8. Wherever there is a practical there will be no tutorial and vice-versa
- 9. A major subject is the subject that's the main focus of Core degree/concerned.
- 10. A minor is a secondary choice of subject that complements core major/concerned.
- 11. Vocational course is a course that enables individual to acquire skills set that are required for a particular job.

- 5. Code 1: First time of that course type [L, AECC, C for DSC, S for SEC, V for VBC and O for OEC] in semester, similarly in reaming semester for such other courses
- 6. Code LK: Language Kannada, similarly Language English, Language Hindi, Language Telugu, Language Sanskrit, & Language Urdu
