## ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Ballari is a beautiful and historical city of Karnataka, which can provide a pleasant experience for all travel enthusiasts. The city tells the tales of many famous battles and dynasties. It is a silent witness of the rise and fall of many empires. The city is situated in the eastern part of Karnataka, the city is bounded by Koppal, Raichur and Chitradurga districts. This historic place stands amidst the level, wide plain of black cotton soil. The traditional culture of Hampi will inspire our minds to be witnesses of this culture and architecture. In addition, Hampi served as the capital city of the Vijayanagara Empire for more than 200 years (around 1336 AD to 1565 AD).

Vijayanagara rulers decorated and designed this city with lots of lovely temples, palaces, market streets and monuments, making this location as one of the famous ancient Metropolitan Cities in India. This super ancient landscape has been selected as a World Heritage site by UNESCO. The prominent places to visit in Hampi are Vittala Temple, Virupaksha Temple, Royal Enclosure, River side trek Path, Hemakuta, Kadale kalu Ganesha, Lakshmi Narasimha, Queen's bath, Lotus Mahal, Hazara Rama Temple and other lovely places.
